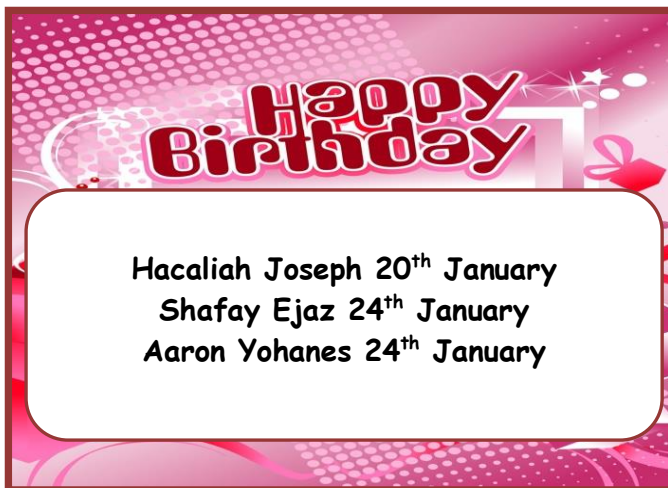

Please spread the message to your family and friends so that they can support us too.

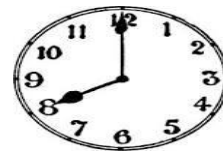
