THINKTANK

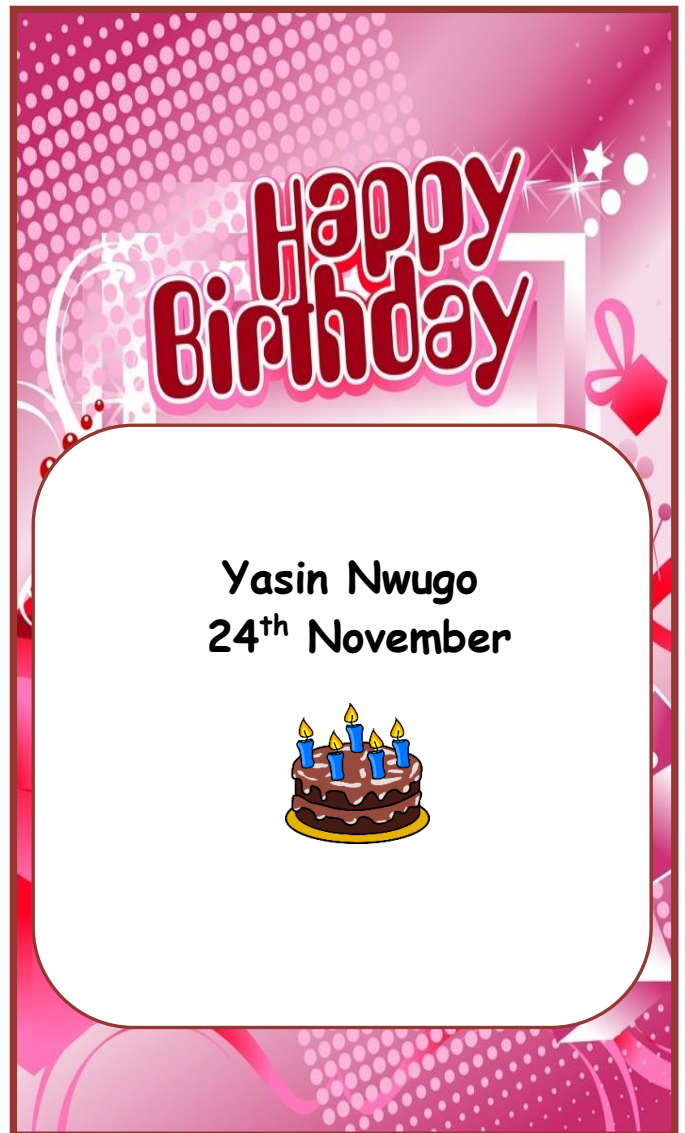
Children from Years 3, 4 and 5 are invited to visit Thinktank with their family for free between Saturday 2nd December and Sunday 17th December 2017.
