## FOOTBALL SUCCESS

St Anne's have had a fantastic year in 6 aside and 7 aside football which sees them end the year winning three tournaments.

September 2017 - St Anne's win the Hallfield Tournament by drawing 1-1 before winning three games on the bounce without conceding and scoring nine more goals. Two individuals from our school Jameil who was clinical in front of goal scoring six goals in four games and Lloyds who kept three clean sheets in four games in his first tournament as a goalkeeper were awarded players of the tournament.

November 2017 – St Anne's win the Birmingham Catholic Schools Qualifiers. St Anne's started the tournament with a 1-0 win thanks to a well worked team goal which was finished off by Jameil. After losing the second game narrowly 2-1 and hitting the crossbar on two occasions St Anne's won the next three games 2-0 with Jameil, Shakyree and Tye all contributing to the goals.

June 2018 - St Anne's win the Birmingham Catholic Schools 7 aside Tournament. Only three teams remained which saw St Anne's pick up a 3-1 win and 0-0 draw in the Finals Day resulting them be crowned the 7 aside champions for 2017-2018.
