They will be learning about what the Curriculum, homework and expectations for the year are.

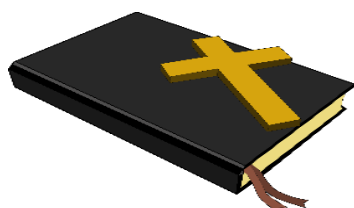
In the Autumn term we will have a Meet the Teacher session for Parents to support this transition.
