PARENTAL AGREEMENT

As a family I/we will try to:

- ensure my child is on time [8.55a.m.] and collected promptly [3pm]
- ensure that he/she attends school every day and will only arrange holidays in school holidays
- inform the school if my child is ill no later than 9.15 a.m. on the day of absence and give a reason by telephone or in person for any absence
- ensure that my child goes to bed at a reasonable time on school days
- support the school's policy on discipline and let the school know of any health or relevant family problems which may affect my child's behaviour or work

- support the school's policies on uniform, jewellery and medicines as described in the School Prospectus
