

Sports Premium

The government provided additional funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013 to 2014 and 2014 to 2015 to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport was to improve the quality and breadth of sport and PE provision, including increasing participation in PE and sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

PE and Sports Grant Allocation 2015-2016

Our school received a grant of £8,892 for primary school sports in the academic year 2015 - 16 (7/12ths 2014/15 + 5/12ths 2015/16). This money will be used in a number of different ways to support the provision of improved quality of sports and PE for all children.
