Introduction

At Saint Anne's school we use the PE and Sport Premium funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport that we offer to all children.

In 2016-2017 our priorities for developing PE and Sport are:

- Having increased numbers of children participating in sport focusing on under-represented groups such as girls.
- Giving staff greater knowledge and confidence to teach PE leading to higher quality PE lessons, so more children will participate in sports inside and outside of school.

At Saint Anne's we use the PE and Sport Premium funding to:

- Run a range of after school clubs for Key Stage One and Key Stage Two including a Change4Life Club.
- Arrange transport to a variety of fixtures throughout the year.
- Purchase new equipment to develop children's skills in PE and during physical activities at play time.
- Use Evolve mentors and sports coaches to support children in their PE lessons and in after school provision.
